What is the name of this element?



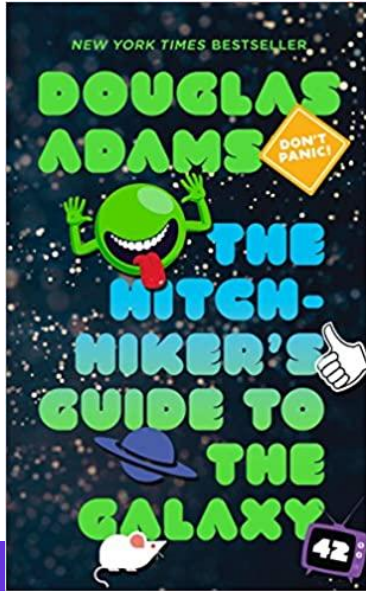

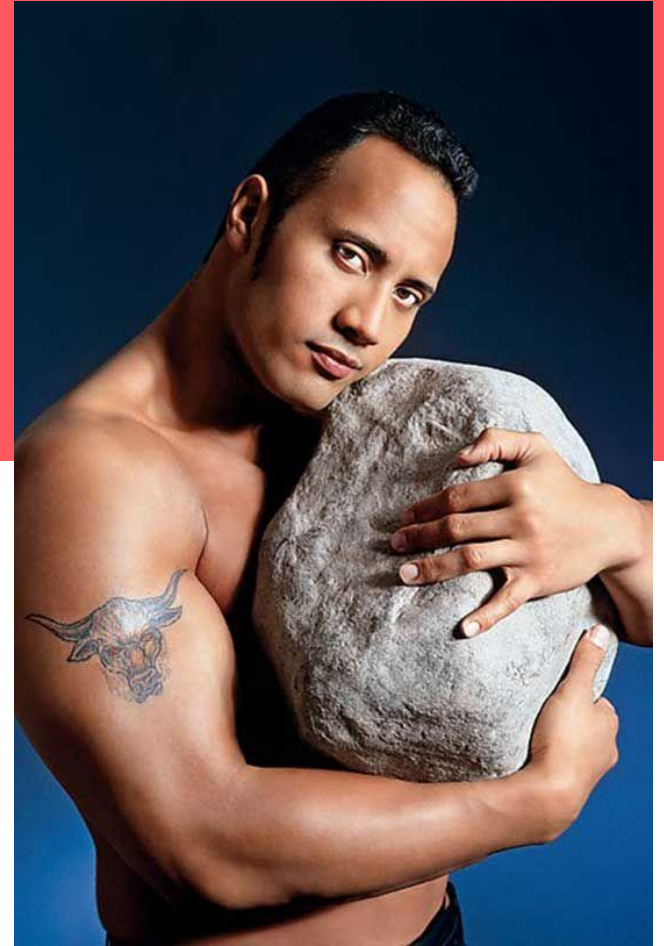
